## Pastor's Page

## "Do not be afraid." <br> --Angel and also Jesus (Matthew 28: 5, 10)

It's such an easy thing to say "Don't be afraid," and it's such a hard thing to do. How does one stop being afraid? When human bodies experience fear, there's an entire cascade of bodily system responses, over which we have little or no control, like the "fight or flight" response. I would reject this advice-"don't be afraid"-if not for my trust in the one who is speaking.

If the risen Christ says, "don't be afraid," it's possible he knows what he's talking about. After having experienced betrayal, isolation, crucifixion, death, and burial, Jesus has already experienced some of the worst of humanity. At that point, is there anything left to be afraid of?

Facing the worst of the world is difficult work, and we're faced with this reality all the time. It's easy to despair and want to give up. During the season of Lent, we have wrestled with faith questions and studied "why we do what we do" in the liturgy we use regularly in worship. We will keep asking questions, like "What is God up to?"

Even on Good Friday, as we contemplate the crucified Christ, we still notice where else in the world Christ is being crucified among the vulnerable and the "least of these." We keep vigil, as believers huddled together, until Jesus comes again, as he promised.

The resurrected Jesus keeps showing up, saying "Don't be afraid." Listen to the Easter story. Keep looking for signs of resurrection. What is God up to? Wherever healing is happening, you can be sure God is part of it.

Palm Sunday<br>Where are you headed?

Join us for the first day of Holy Week, April 2nd, with the waving of palm branches and the singing of some of our favorite hymns. Hear how Jesus entered into Jerusalem on a donkey and was welcomed by crowds waving palm branches and lining the streets with their cloaks. We will start worship outside, in the front yard by the sign. Please plan to arrive early enough to grab your bulletin and a palm branch. Those unable to join us outside will be able to hear the service from their pews.

Good Friday Why have you forsaken me?

Hear the Passion of Our Lord Jesus Christ according to John. During the reading, members of the congregation will share news articles demonstrating current acts of hostility against our neighbors from around the world as well as to the land itself.

Will you wash my feet?
On Maundy Thursday, learn about how Jesus washed the feet of his disciples. Then take part in a special Communion where we will gather as one group in the front of the church to share Jesus' last supper.

The Vigil of Easter: This is the Night!
Join Bishop Candea and siblings from St. Louis area ELCA churches for the Vigil of Easter, held this year on Saturday, April 8th, at 7:30pm, at Gethsemane Lutheran Church.

This capstone to the great Three Days of Holy Week will include storytelling, the striking of a new fire, affirmation of baptism, and the first eucharist of the Easter season.

With a light reception to follow, this is a great time of fellowship and worship with folks from across the region at the pinnacle of the church year!
